

AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO THE CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

UNITED NATIONS ENTITY FOR GENDER EQUALITY AND THE EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN (UN-Women)

AND

THE NORWEGIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MFA)

Reference is made to the Cost Sharing Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") dated 23/12/2013 between the UNITED NATIONS ENTITY FOR GENDER EQUALITY AND THE EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN (UN-Women) and the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA), with respect to the MWI-13/0026 UN-Women Gender and Agriculture Project, and as per Article XVII describing the Amendment of the Agreement, stating that any Annexes thereto may be modified or amended only by written agreement between the Parties.

WHEREAS the MFA and UN Women now wish to amend the said Agreement in order to extend the commitment to the Project for a bridging period until June 2015 to facilitate continuation of activities under the Project prior to entering into a second phase of the Project.

WHEREAS such Amendment will result in an increase of up to NOK 3,556,012.00 making the contribution under the Agreement a total of NOK 6,556,012.

NOW THEREFORE the Parties agree as follows:

Article IV, clause 1 shall be amended such that the Contribution shall be NOK 6,556,012 and the Support Period shall be 2013 to 30 June 2015.

Article IV, clause 2 shall be amended to add the following:

Upon signature of Amendment No. 1	NOK 2,000,000
March 2015	Up to remaining funds

NEVERTHELESS, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.

The amendment will enter into effect upon signature by both Parties.
