Addendum No. 1 to the Agreement on Delegated Cooperation dated April 19th, 2011

GERMAN-NORWEGIAN INITIATIVE TO REDUCE MATERNAL MORTALITY IN MALAWI (RESULTS BASED FINANCING FOR MATERNAL AND NEONATAL HEALTH- RBF4MNH)

According to the Agreement on delegated Cooperation between Kfw and the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs regarding support to German-Norwegian Initiative to reduce Maternal Mortality in Malawi signed on 19th April, 2011, section VII states that the agreement will end on December 31, 2014 unless prolonged by the Parties in writing.

We would like to inform you that Norway is prepared to consider a No Cost Extension (no additional funding) to the programme until end 2015 pending a request from Kfw. If a no cost extension is granted, this will mean that the funds which are planned under this agreement will still be available for the programme to be implemented until end 2015 since implementation started late.

This is also in support of the confirmation by Kfw in the meeting of August 12th 2013, between Kfw and the Norwegian Embassy, where Kfw reiterated that among others, the EURO 5 million

committed by German Government will be used to mainly extend the implementation period of the RBF4MNH programme until end of 2015. Depending on the result of the pilot, Norway might also consider increasing funding to the programme.
